

## MISCELLANEOUS FACTS AND FIGURES 2019

Our 2019 playing record was: Played 28, Won 17, Drew 2, Tied 1, Lost 6 and Abandoned 2. The games against Monken Hadley and Little Berkhamsted Sahibs were cancelled due to the opposition being unable to field a team. In both instances we were able to pick up conference fixtures at Great Missenden Pelicans and Chingford respectively. The games Sawbridgeworth (July) and Ley Hill were both cancelled due to the weather before a ball had been bowled.

We scored a total of 5764 (including 548 extras) for the loss of 163 wickets – an average of 35.36 runs per wicket. Our runs came off 1048.1 overs – an average of 5.50 runs per over. We conceded a total of 5293 runs (including 429 extras) and took 217 wickets – an average of 24.39 runs per wicket. Opponents' runs came off 1034.3 overs – an average of 5.12 runs per over.

We lost our wickets in the following ways: 83 caught, 47 bowled, 15 lbw, 12 run out and 6 stumped. Opponents lost their wickets in the following ways: 90 caught, 90 bowled, 13 run out, 12 stumped, 9 lbw and 3 retired out.

Our highest total: 279 for 4 v Chipperfield Clarendon on May 12 (Record: 326 for 4 v Ley Hill). Our lowest all-out total: 153 v Hemel Hempstead on June 6 (Record: 28 v Old Elizabethans 3rds). Highest total by opposition: 280 for 8 by Chipperfield Clarendon on May 12 (Record: 325 for 4 by Harlow Town in 2006). Lowest all-out total by opposition: 128 by Harlow Town on July 14 (Record: 13 by Potters Bar Crusaders).

Our highest total to win batting second: 247 for 4 v Watton-at-Stone on September 9 (Record: 262 for 7 v Essendon). Highest total by opposition to win batting second: 280 for 8 by Chipperfield Clarendon on May 12 (Record: 295 for 8 by Cockfosters).

Our highest individual score of the season: 119 by C. R. Jones v Chipperfield Clarendon on May 12 (Record: 213 by D. Rock in 2013). Our best individual bowling: 5 for 29 by C. E. J. Simmons v Hoddesdon on July 21 (Record: 9 for 44 by Bennett). Highest individual score by opponent: 206 - by L. Stove for Chipperfield Clarendon on May 12 (NEW RECORD – Previous record: 170 by D. Lyon for Knebworth Park). Best individual bowling figures by an opponent: 3 for 4 by G. Morris for Hemel Hempstead on June 6 (Record: 9 for 42 by S. Nash of Datchworth and 8 for 3 by W. Calver for Old Elizabethans 3rds).

We won the toss in 17 games and batted first on 15 of those occasions. Out of 28 matches altogether, we batted first 17 times, meaning we were asked to bat first on 2 occasions.

### BEST PERFORMANCES

Career best scores for RRs were recorded in 2019 by C. R. Jones (119 v Chipperfield Clarendon on May 12) and J. A. Pike (100 v Black Sheep on August 6).

Career best bowling figures were recorded in 2019 by B. J. Candy (5 for 30 v Harlow Town on July 14).

### PERSONAL LANDMARKS

The following landmarks were reached during 2019: J. A. Pike played his 200<sup>th</sup> game and both D. T. Mills and M. Watson played their 100<sup>th</sup> game. P. R. Lewis passed 7000 runs, D. E. F. Simmons passed 6000 runs, D. T. Mills, P. Smith and S. J. Wiggins passed 3000 runs, J. A. Pike passed 2000 runs. C. R. Jones took his 300<sup>th</sup> wicket.

### OVERALL PLAYING RECORD (1974 TO 2019)

Played 1362, Won 634, Drew 279, Tied 9, Lost 392, Abandoned 48. Another 155 games have been cancelled without a ball being bowled due to the weather.
